

2018 LPGA DRUGS OF ABUSE LIST

The following substances which are normally associated with social abuse (and are often times obtained illegally) rather than athletic performance enhancement and which go against the spirit of our sport will be considered Drugs of Abuse under the LPGA's Anti-Doping Program:

Cannabinoids (e.g., cannabis, hashish and marijuana), Synthetic cannabinoids (e.g., Δ^9 -tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) and other cannabimimetics;

Buprenorphine;

Dextromoramide;

Diamorphine (heroin);

Fentanyl and its derivatives;

Hydromorphone;

Methadone;

Morphine;

Nicomorphine;

Oxycodone;

Oxymorphone;

Pentazocine; and

Pethidine.
