LPGA DRUGS OF ABUSE LIST

The following substances which are normally associated with social abuse (and are often times obtained illegally) rather than athletic performance enhancement and which go against the spirit of our sport will be considered Drugs of Abuse under the LPGA's Anti-Doping Program: Cannabinoids (e.g., marijuana), Synthetic THC and Cannabimimetics (JWH018, JWH073, and HU-210), Phencyclidine (PCP), Benzylpiperazine (BZP), and the following narcotics, Buprenorphine (Suboxone), Dextromoramide, Diamorphine (heroin), Fentanyl (Fentora, Duragesic) and derivatives, Hydromorphone (Dilaudid), Methadone, Morphine (Avinza, Kadian, MS Contin, MSIR), Oxycodone (Percocet, Roxicet, Tylox), Oxymorphone (Opana, OpanaER), Pentazocine (Talwin, Talacen), and Pethidine.
