- 2. Career Top-20: Members in the Top-20 on the Career Money List as of the end of the last Official Tournament of the previous year. Priority is based on the order of the list. To be included in this category (a) the Member must notify the LPGA that she wants to be included in the Career Top-20 Category by December 15 of the previous year, (b) if a Member elects to be included in the Career Top-20 Category, she will be in this Category for one year, (c) a Member may be included in this category only two times in her career, and (d) a Member may only be in the Career Top-20 Category or the Career Top-40 Category (but not both) in her career.
- Major Winner: Members who have won an LPGA Major Championship while a Member during the previous five (5) years. Priority is based on the number of such wins during the previous five (5) years or during the current year. Ties are broken by the Members' positions on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year.

- 4. <u>Winner:</u> Members who have won an Official Tournament while a Member within the last two (2) years or during the current year. Priority is based on the number of Official Tournament wins during the previous two (2) years. Ties are broken by the Members' positions on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year.

- 5. <u>Multiple Wins</u>: Members who have won at least two (2) Official Tournaments while a Member during the previous four (4) years (2011-2014). Priority is based on the number of wins during the previous four (4) years. Ties are broken by the Members' positions on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year.

Beginning in 2016, Members who have won two (2) Official Tournaments in the same calendar year during the previous three (3) years (2013-2015). Priority is based on the number of wins during the previous three years. Ties are broken by the Members' positions on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year.

Priority is based on the earliest date of such wins. A Player must be eligible and accept LPGA membership to be eligible in this category.

For the remaining Official Tournaments of the year, Members in the Top 80 on the current year's Money List after the Walmart NW Arkansas Championship presented by P&G. Priority is based on the order of the list. Ties are broken by the Members' positions on the 2015 Priority List as of the commitment deadline for each respective reshuffle tournament.
- 9. <u>Top-10 LPGA Symetra Tour:</u> Top-10 on the previous year's season-ending Symetra Tour Money List. Priority is based on their position on the list.

- 14. <u>Career Top-40 Category:</u> Members in the Top-40 on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year. Priority is based on the order of the list. To be included in this category (a) the Member must notify the LPGA that she wants to be included in the Career Top-40 Category by December 15 of the previous year, and (b) if a Member elects to be included in the Career Top-40 Category she will be in this category for one year, (c) a Member may be included in this category only one time in her career, (d) a Member may only be in the Career Top-40 Category or the Career Top-20 Category (but not both) in her career.

### A. NOTE:

- 1. <u>T&CP Entries:</u> The Champion of the most recent LPGA Teaching and Club Professional (T&CP) National Championship may enter one (1) Standard Eligibility Tournament during her tenure as Champion, falling in priority behind Category 18.
- 2. Medical, Maternity and Family Leave Extensions: A Member who receives an extension of status for medical, maternity or family leave will slot in the priority list position that most closely approximates the position which she was assigned at the beginning of the previous LPGA Tour season. If upon the Member's return to competition, the Member's position on the priority list gains her entry into a limited, no-cut field, such Member will only gain access to the event if she had been eligible to gain entry into such event in the previous year, but was unable to compete due to her medical, maternity or family leave extension.

### B. Special Entries

Nine (9) places, as applicable, will be reserved in Standard Eligibility Tournaments as follows:

- 1. <u>Hall of Fame/Tournament Winners Entries:</u> Two (2) places will be reserved for LPGA and World Golf Hall of Fame Members not otherwise eligible. Priority is based on the number of Official Tournament wins as of the end of the previous year. Any ties will be broken by the Members' positions on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year.
  - Any such places not used by Hall of Fame Members will be reserved for Members, not otherwise eligible, who have won eight (8) or more Official Tournaments held within the previous twenty (20) years, with priority based on the number of wins. Any ties will be broken by the Members' positions on the Career Money List as of the end of the previous year. A Member who has won eight (8) or more tournaments may enter no more than two (2) tournaments a year through this entry criterion.
- 2. **Sponsor Invitations**: Two (2) places will be reserved for sponsor invitations (in special circumstances necessitated by a tournament location outside the United States or by a sponsor from another country, a limited number of additional sponsor invitations may be made available).
- 3. Local Qualifying: Two (2) places will be reserved for Players competing in a local qualifying round.
- 4. Previous Week Top 10: Two (2) places will be reserved for Members, not otherwise qualified, who finish within the top 10 and ties of the previous Standard Eligibility Tournament (Top 10 Event). If Members are tied for the second position, the tie will be broken by the lowest, most recent round in the previous Standard Eligibility Tournament, and, if necessary, by a match of cards starting with the 18<sup>th</sup> hole of the final round and working backward. If the LPGA tournament immediately following the Top 10 Event is not a Standard Eligibility Tournament, the Members shall then be entitled to places in the field for the very next Standard Eligibility Tournament within the same calendar year. Members must have committed to the tournament by the commitment deadline to be eligible through this category.
- 5. <u>Late Entries</u>: One (1) place will be reserved for a Member who wins the immediately preceding week's Standard Eligibility Tournament and other designated tournaments. To enter a tournament after the commitment deadline in this category the Member must notify an LPGA Rules Official at the site of the immediately preceding tournament of her intention to enter no later than one hour after the conclusion of tournament play at the immediately preceding tournament.
