Dress Code

All courses have a dress code policy that will apply: either a collar or sleeves on shirts. No tank tops allowed. Shorts must have appropriate golf length and no denim of any kind. Dress code applies to players, observers and caddies alike. Players shall present a neat appearance appropriate to the game of golf in both clothing and grooming. Mission Hills is a spike less facility. Caddies must wear a smooth, rubber soled shoes, preferably tennis or basketball shoes. No golf shoes. Flip-flops, sandals or opened toed shoes are not allowed. (Caddie guidelines attached)

Cart Rule

Each player will have their own cart for tournament competition. Carts <u>will not</u> be available prior to tee time. Carts will be staged by the practice putting green. Caddies may ride with their player. Small coolers are allowed on carts and highly recommended. Once your round is complete, please return cart to the staging area by the putting green.

Practice Requirements

Practice rounds will be on Monday, August 22nd Tuesday, August 23rd and Wednesday, August 24th (no additional fees will be charged). Practice round tee times will be made <u>available at player registration and not through the golf shop.</u> Please register before play. Due to the large number of participants in the field only 2 carts will be allowed per group. Please abide by this request so we can accommodate all players.

Driving Range

Complimentary Titleist range balls will be available at Mission Hills driving range only beginning Tuesday, August 23rd. Sunday, August 28th from 5:45 a.m.-6:00 p.m. (times may change; please plan accordingly).

Advance Practice

The Mission Hills Country Club Membership is pleased to host the LPGA Q-School! We hope that the participants understand that Mission Hills is a private club and adhering to the club's policies and procedures are a must. As this event falls in the off season, players will have plenty of opportunity for practice rounds. Provided below is information on course availability and guidelines for use of the facility:

- Please call the golf shop directly to schedule your <u>advance tee times</u> 760-324-7336. Golf shop hours are 6:00 a.m.-2:00 p.m.
- Player rate: \$45 per player for participants and you may bring a guest for \$55 with approval of the golf shop
- Qualifying School official practice round tee times will be made at player registration.

2016 CADDIE REGULATIONS

A Player may be penalized for the actions of her caddie and caddies are subject to suspensions.

- 1. Caddies must wear smooth, rubber-soled shoes, preferably tennis or basketball shoes. No golf shoes. "Duck" shoes are not considered to be smooth, rubber-soled shoes. Flip-flops, sandals or opened toed shoes are not allowed.
- 2. Caddies shall not wear cut-off shorts or gym/running shorts at any time while on tournament property. Shorts must be hemmed and of appropriate length (no cut-offs).
- 3. Caddies shall not be permitted on practice putting greens except to retrieve pitch and run shots (no lofted shots). Provided the putting green is not damaged and is not crowded, caddies may retrieve (shag) putts. AT NO TIME MAY A CADDIE SIT OR LIE ON A PUTTING GREEN.
- 4. Caddies shall not walk on greens when checking hole positions. When not caddying during a round, caddies are not permitted on any hole that has been played or is being played until the final group has completed play on that hole. During practice rounds, they may walk on the greens to chart information as long as this does not interfere with the practice of any player.
- 5. Caddies shall not have or consume alcoholic beverages, including beer, except in designated areas at the tournament site. Cell phones are prohibited during tournament rounds. Any behavior deemed inappropriate by the Director of Tournament Operations may result in an immediate suspension of the caddie from tournament property and/or from one or more tournaments.
- 6. Caddies are not permitted to play the tournament course or use the practice facilities of the host venue from Registration day on through the end of the tournament.
- 7. Caddies and Players may use the cart for transporting items such as water bottles, rain gear and extra clothing.
- 8. Caddies may only be employed by one Player during a tournament round, and if fired, may not be re-hired during the same tournament round.
