Career

- In 2004, competed in 10 Futures Tour events, where her best finish was a tie for 23rd; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament Presented by American Airlines, where she tied for 55th to retain non-exempt status for the 2005 season.
- In 2003, was in a car accident and suffered whiplash in her neck and shoulder and strained her wrist; competed in eight events on the Futures Tour, where her best finish was a tie for 20th.
- In 2002, was in a car accident in April and suffered severe whiplash and cervical, thoracic and lumbar strains that required several months of rehabilitation; competed in only three events due to the injuries.
- In 2001, tied for 45th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2002 season; competed on the SBC Futures Tour, where her best finish was a tie for 10th at the Aurora Health Care Futures Classic.
- In August 2000, turned professional.

Amateur

Rizzo competed in the U.S. Women's Amateur Championship in 1998 and 2000. In 2000, she placed in the top 15 at the U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links Championship. During her collegiate career, she won the State Farm Collegiate in 1999 and placed in the top five on four separate occasions. She was a two-time Academic All-American at the University of Oregon.
