- In 2005, missed the second-half of the season after an emergency appendectomy in July.
- In 2004, recorded her career-best finish at the ShopRite LPGA Classic, where she tied for 27th; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 55th to earn non-exempt status for the 2005 season.
- In 2003, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 65th to earn non-exempt status for the 2004 season.
- In 2002, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 24th to earn non-exempt status for the 2003 season; recorded one top-10 finish on the Futures Tour.
- In 2000, tied for 42nd at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2001 season.
- From 1996-2000, competed on the Futures Tour; compiled seven top-10 finishes from 1999-2000, including a tie for second at the 2000 Lima Futures Classic.
- In 1996, turned professional.

Amateur

Cap's impressive amateur resume begins with a win at the 1990 Ohio Girls High School State Championship. At Methodist College, she was a four-time Division III All-American and a member of the four-time Division III National Championship team (1992-95). Cap won four collegiate Division I golf tournaments and represented the United States in the USA versus Japan Matches in 1995. In 1992 and 1994, Cap was a semifinalist at the Ohio State Women's Amateur and made it to the final 16 of the North and South Women's Amateur Championship in 1994.
