Professional

Career

- In 2004, recorded her season-best finish at the ShopRite LPGA Classic, where she tied for sixth; crossed the \$4 million mark in career earnings at the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by Coca-Cola.
- In 2003, posted three top 10s, including a tie for second at the John Q. Hammons Hotel Classic.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for fifth at the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic.
- In 2001, finished second at the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic for her best finish of the season.
- In 2000, top finish was a tie for 16th at the Philips Invitational Honoring Harvey Penick.
- In 1999, tied for third at the LPGA Corning Classic for her best finish of the season; recorded her fifth LPGA career hole-in-one during the third round of the ShopRite LPGA Classic.
- In 1998, was the first player ever to compete in The Solheim Cup while pregnant and posted a 1-2 record for the victorious U.S. Team; recorded her seventh career victory at the LPGA Corning Classic; crossed the \$3 million mark in career earnings after a tie for seventh at the U.S. Women's Open; gave birth to daughter Tina Marie.
- In 1997, won the Sprint Titleholders Championship and the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic for the second time.
- In 1996, competed in just 17 events due to surgery; top finish was a tie for third at the SAFECO Classic, where she recorded the fourth hole-in-one of her LPGA career during the second round.
- In 1995, had eight top-10 finishes, including a second-place finish at the Fieldcrest Cannon Classic.
- In 1994, posted eight top-10 finishes, including a victory at the Youngstown-Warren LPGA Classic and three runner-up finishes; was a member of the victorious U.S. Solheim Cup Team.
- In 1993, won two events—the HEALTHSOUTH Palm Beach Classic and the Rochester International, during which she recorded a career-low 63 during the third round; posted her third LPGA career hole-in-one during the SAFECO Classic.
- In 1992, best finish was a tie for second at the Jamie Farr Toledo Classic; recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the Mazda Japan Classic.
- In 1991, best finish was a tie for second at the Crestar-Farm Fresh Classic, where she made the first ace of her LPGA career.
- In 1990, placed fourth at both the Rochester International and the Japan Airlines Big Apple Classic and tied for fourth at the SAFECO Classic.
- In 1989, became a Rolex First-Time Winner by capturing the du Maurier Ltd. Classic title, one of the LPGA's four major championships at the time.
- In 1988, posted six top 10s, including a second-place finish at the Sara Lee Classic.
- In 1987, named LPGA Rookie of the Year on the strength of four top-10 finishes, including a season-best fourth place at the Chrysler-Plymouth Classic.
- In 1986, tied for second at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn exempt status for the 1987 season; prior to joining the LPGA Tour, won 10 titles on the Futures Tour and was the leading money winner from 1985-86; qualified for the U.S. Women's Open and tied for 14th.

Amateur

Green was a member of the Marshall University golf team and won four collegiate events, three of which she won during her senior year in 1982. Green earned low-amateur honors at the 1981 LPGA Wheeling Classic.
