- In 2005, competed on the Asian Tour and recorded a top-10 finish at the Taiwan Open; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 39th to retain non-exempt status for the 2006 LPGA season.
- In 2004, joined the BMO Financial Group Canadian Women's Tour and the West Coast Ladies Golf Tour, posting one win on each circuit; won the RE/MAX Long Drive Contest on the Futures Tour with a 269-yard drive; tied for 42nd at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2005 LPGA season.
- In 2003, joined the Women's Asian Tour.
- In 2002, turned professional in March and joined the Futures Tour, where her career-best finish as a professional is a tie for 22nd.

Amateur

Tucker's amateur resume includes wins at the 1998 Lafayette Indiana Elks Tour tournament and 1998 Memphis Women's Intercollegiate Championship. Also in 1998, she finished fourth at both the Indiana Women's Open Championship and Indiana Women's Amateur Championship. Tucker tied for 16th at the 1999 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship. Her second collegiate win came at the 2000 San Antonio Shootout, and Tucker earned All-Big Ten honors, as well as an NCAA All-American Honorable Mention, in 1999-2000. She competed for the U.S. Teams at both the World Collegiate Championships (2000) and in the USA vs. Japan Matches (2001).
