Cochran had a decorated amateur career. As a junior, she was named the *Los Angeles Times* Girls' Golfer of the Year and an American Junior Golf Association (AJGA) First-Team All-American in 2003. She was the California Interscholastic Federation (CIF) champion from 2001-03 and the CIF State Champion in 2003. She earned medalist honors at the 2004 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship. Cochran was a member of the U.S. PING Junior Solheim Cup Team and Canon Cup West Team in 2003. She won the 2004 Seoul Invitational in Hawaii and had one collegiate victory at UCLA. She earned Second-Team National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA) All-America and First-Team All-Pac-10 honors in 2005.
