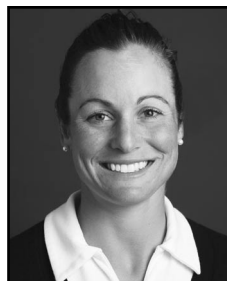


# Liz Janangelo

## Professional

### Career

- In 2007, was a two-time winner on the Duramed Futures Tour at the Greater Tampa Duramed FUTURES Classic and the Mercedes-Benz of Kansas City Championship; recorded seven additional top-10 finishes in 19 starts; tied for 14<sup>th</sup> at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn exempt status for the 2008 LPGA season.
- In 2006, turned professional in May; competed in seven events on the Duramed Futures Tour.

## Amateur

Janangelo was one of the country's top amateurs as a junior. She was the top player on the boys high school golf team as a freshman and sophomore. On the American Junior Golf Association (AJGA) circuit, she won eight events, including the 2001 Betsy Rawls Junior Girls Championship and Polo Junior Classic. She was a two-time Polo Golf First-Team All-America selection in 2001-02, and was the 2001 Polo Golf Girls Junior Player of the Year. She was the top-ranked player in the 2001 *Golfweek* Sagarin Performance rankings and a five-time Connecticut Women's Amateur Champion. At Duke University, she became the third freshman golfer in school history to be a National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA) First-Team All-American selection, and was also named the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) Freshman of the Year. At the Connecticut State Open, Janangelo won back-to-back championships in 2003-04. In 2004, she was the first Blue Devil to be named the *Golfweek* College Player of the Year and also played a leading role on the victorious U.S. Curtis Cup Team. That same year, she was selected as the Division I 2004 PING NGCA Player of the Year. In 2005, Janangelo carded a Duke and NCAA-record round of 62 at the ACC/SEC Challenge. She topped the school's all-time list with 30 top-10 finishes and was a four-time All-ACC selection. As an amateur, she also competed on the Duramed Futures Tour in one event each of the following years: 1999, 2000, 2002 and 2005.
