Professional

2007

- Played in only eight events after giving birth to son Logan James in April.
- Recorded a season-low tie for 10th at The Mitchell Company LPGA Tournament of Champions, where she carded a season-low 67 in the second round.

Career

- In 2006, best finish was fourth place at the SBS Open at Turtle Bay, where she crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings; tied for 10th at the Weetabix Women's British Open.
- In 2005, recorded a season-best tie for 10th at the U.S. Women's Open; tied for 11th at the Weetabix Women's British Open; was a member of the European Solheim Cup Team.
- In 2004, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the Welch's/Fry's Championship, where she recorded a career-low 63 during both the first and last rounds to set an LPGA record for lowest four-day raw score total at 258 (-22); won the Weetabix Women's British Open, where she became only the second player in history to record a double-eagle at an LPGA major championship (began the final round with an eagle, double-eagle on the first two holes); crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings at the U.S. Women's Open.
- In 2003, best finish was fourth place at the State Farm Classic.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for third at the Safeway Classic.
- In 2001, recorded a season-best tie for ninth at the ShopRite LPGA Classic.
- In 2000, best finish was seventh place at the Kathy Ireland Greens.com LPGA Classic.
- In 1999, best finish was a tie for eighth at the State Farm Rail Classic; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 17th to earn exempt status for the 2000 season.
- In 1998, turned professional following the U.S. Women's Amateur Championship; qualified for the Tour by tying for 52nd at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1999 season.

Amateur

Stupples represented Great Britain in the 1996 and 1998 Curtis Cup competitions. She also represented England Juniors from 1989-91 and England Seniors from 1995-98. She played collegiate golf at Florida State University, winning two events and being named a Second-Team All-American in 1995.
