Professional

2008

- Recorded a career-best tie for 11th at the Corona Championship
- Tied her career-low round of 68 in the first round of the Fields Open in Hawaii.
- Returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for fourth to earn Priority List Category 11 for the 2009 LPGA season.
- Best finish on the Ladies European Tour (LET) was fourth at the Dubai Ladies Masters.

Career

- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 26th at the Corona Championship, where she carded a career-low 68 in the final round; also carded a 68 in the second round of the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger; played in 15 events on the LET earning her first international win at the Ladies Open of Portugal.
- In 2006, played in 16 events on the LET, with four top-10 finishes.
- In 2005, played in 15 events on the LET, with two top-10 finishes.
- In 2004, played in 13 events on the LET.
- In 2003, turned professional in November.

Amateur

Giquel won a Gold Medal at the 2001 Mediterranean Games and helped France to a third-place finish at the 2003 European Team Championship. She finished third at the 2001 Biarritz Ladies Classic, an LET event. Giquel was a five-time French champion, including four times in stroke play and once in match play. She was a two-time winner of the French Cup.
