Professional

Career

- In 2008, competed in 16 events on the Duramed FUTURES Tour, including a season-best tie for sixth at both the Bright House Networks Open and CIGNA Golf Classic; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she carded a hole-in-one during the second round and tied for 34th to earn Priority List Category 20 for the 2009 LPGA season.
- In 2006-07, competed on the Duramed FUTURES Tour, winning the 2007 Louisiana Pelican Classic.
- In 2004, competed on the Futures Tour; tied for 52nd at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament Presented by American Airlines to earn non-exempt status for the 2005 LPGA season.
- In 2003, played in 16 events on the Futures Tour and posted a career-best tie for 12th at the GE Futures Professional Golf Classic.
- In 2002, turned professional in October.

Amateur

Howland has an impressive amateur resume. In 1997, she was on the NAIA National Championship-winning women's golf team at Tri-State University. Her collegiate resume also includes finishing runner-up at the 1998 Tri-State Championship and winning the 1998 Manchester Championship. After transferring to Lamar University, Howland won two tournaments in 1999, the Sam Houston State Championship and the Springlake Championship. After college, she won the 2001 Bermuda Match Play Championship. Howland also dominated women's amateur golf in Idaho, winning both the Women's Stroke Play and Match Play Championships in 2001 and 2002.
