Professional

2008

- Best finish was a tie for 14th at the SemGroup Championship Presented by John Q. Hammons.
- Carded a season-low 67 in the final round of the Navistar LPGA Classic Presented by MaxxForce.

Career

- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 11th at the LPGA Corning Classic, where she tied her career-low 66 in the first round.
- In 2006, best finish was a tie for 16th at the CN Canadian Women's Open.
- In 2005, best finish was a tie for 13th at the U.S. Women's Open, her career-best finish in a major.
- In 2004, best finish was a tie for seventh at the BMO Financial Group Canadian Women's Open; tied her career-low 66

during the second round of the Wendy's Championship for Children.

- In 2003, recorded her career-best finish with a tie for second at the John Q. Hammons Hotel Classic.
- In 2002, tied for seventh in her final event of the season, the Safeway Classic; tied her career-low 66 during the final round of the Williams Championship, where she tied for 20th.
- In 2001, ended the season with a tie for sixth place at the Asahi Ryokuken International Championship at Mount Vintage, earning \$30,997 to secure non-exempt status for the 2002 LPGA season.
- In 2000, competed on the Futures Tour, where she was named Rookie of the Year on the strength of nine top-10 finishes; tied for 27th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2001 LPGA season.
- In 1999, best finish of her rookie season was a tie for 15th at the LPGA Corning Classic, where she fired a career-low 66 during the second round; did not retain her LPGA Tour card for the 2000 LPGA season.
- In 1998, turned professional and tied for 28th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1999 LPGA season.

Amateur

At the age of 18, Hullett captured the Texace American Junior Golf Association (AJGA) Championship. Two years later, she won the 1996 Broadmoor Invitational and the 1997 Southern Amateur. As a member of Texas A&M University's golf team, she was the Southwest Conference co-medalist in 1995 and a Second-Team All-American in 1997.
