Professional

2009

- Best finish was runner-up at the U.S. Women's Open - her best finish in a major championship.
- Crossed the \$4 million mark in career earnings with a tie for eighth at the Sybase Classic Presented by ShopRite.
- Carded a season-low 66 in the third round of the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger, where she tied for 33rd.

Career

- In 2008, recorded her fourth LPGA Tour victory at the Hana Bank * KOLON Championship 2008; recorded five additional top-10 finishes, including a tie for second at the Navistar LPGA Classic Presented by MaxxFORCE, where she and Cristie Kerr lost a two-hole, sudden-death playoff to Lorena Ochoa.
- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 18th at both the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger and the CN Canadian Women's Open; crossed the \$3 million mark in career earnings at the Wegmans LPGA.
- In 2006, recorded three top-10 finishes, including a tie for third at the Honda LPGA Thailand 2006; carded a 28 (-8) on her front nine of the third round at the Wendy's Championship for Children to tie an LPGA nine-hole record in relation to par.
- In 2005, recorded seven top-10 finishes, including a runner-up finish at the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez, where she crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings; finished fourth at the HSBC Women's World Match Play Championship, where she defeated top-ranked Annika Sorenstam in the quarterfinals before losing to eventual champion Marisa Baena in the semifinals.
- In 2004, best of 10 top-10 finishes was third place at the John Q. Hammons Hotel Classic presented by Ford; tied for third

at The Mitchell Company Tournament of Champions, where she tied her career-low 64 during the third round.

- In 2003, won three tournaments: the LPGA Takefuji Classic, Wachovia LPGA Classic hosted by Betsy King and the rain-shortened State Farm Classic, where she crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings; carded career-low 64s during the first rounds of the Wendy's Championship for Children at Tartan Fields and the State Farm Classic.
- In 2002, tied for fourth at the Weetabix Women's British Open; recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the third round of the Wegmans Rochester LPGA.
- In 2001, turned professional in August; competed on the Futures Tour, where she won the final event of the season, the Futures Tour Championship; tied for 15th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2002 LPGA season.

Amateur

Kung was a three-time American Junior Golf Association (AJGA) All-American and was named 1999 AJGA Player of the Year. She won the 2001 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links Championship. While at the University of Southern California, Kung was a two-time NCAA All-American and won the 2000 Pac-10 Championship.
