Professional

Career

- In 2005, underwent elbow surgery in May and did not compete until August.
- In 2004, posted a season-best finish at the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi, where she tied for fourth.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for sixth at the Sybase Big Apple Classic presented by Lincoln Mercury; gave birth to her second child, daughter Natalie MaKenna, on Feb. 20.

- In 2002, best finish was fourth place at the Wegmans Rochester LPGA; did not play after August due to pregnancy.
- In 2001, tied for seventh at the Weetabix Women's British Open for her season-best finish, which was her career-best finish in a major championship.
- In 2000, best finish of the season was fourth place at the Kathy Ireland Greens.com LPGA Classic.
- In 1999, best finish was a tie for 13th at the First Union Betsy King Classic; fired a career-low 64 during the first round of the New Albany Golf Classic.
- In 1998, played a limited schedule due to sciatica developed during her pregnancy; gave birth to first child, Nicholas, on Dec. 29.
- In 1997, best finish of the season was fourth place at the Fieldcrest Cannon Classic, where she posted all four rounds in the 60s.
- In 1996, posted a career-best finish of second place at the Standard Register PING.
- In 1995, best finish was a tie for 20th at the Cup Noodles Hawaiian Ladies Open.
- In 1994, tied for 41st at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1995 LPGA season.
- In 1987, turned professional in August; was a member of the Futures Tour (1988-94), West Coast Tour (1988), Asian Tour (1989-91), Australian Ladies Professional Golf Tour (1992-2001) and Women Professional Golfers' European Tour (1991-94).

Amateur

During her junior career, Parker-Manzo captured more than 30 junior titles, including the 1982 Junior World Championship. She was a four-time tournament winner while on a full golf scholarship for the UCLA golf team and a three-time NCAA All-American.
