Career

- In 2006, best finish was a tie for 20th at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger.
- In 2005, best finish was a tie for 23rd at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for 15th at the LPGA Takefuji Classic.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for 12th at the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by AIG, her career-best finish in

a major.

- In 2001, best finish was a tie for third at The Office Depot; carded a career-low 63 in the final round of the Standard Register PING; recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the Wendy's Championship for Children at New Albany.
- In 2000, posted a season-best tie for 16th at the Welch's/Circle K Championship.
- In 1999, best finish was a tie for 11th at the Longs Drugs Challenge.
- In 1998, recorded two top 10s: tied for sixth at the Oldsmobile Classic and tied for eighth at the Cup Noodles Hawaiian Ladies Open.
- In 1997, best finish was a tie for fourth at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 1996, recorded a career-best finish with a tie for third at the PING Welch's Championship in Tucson.
- In 1995, top finish was a tie for seventh at the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship; recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round of the Youngstown-Warren LPGA Classic.
- In 1994, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 35th to earn non-exempt status for the 1995 season.
- In 1993, qualified for the Tour by tying for 32nd at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1994 season.
- Prior to joining the LPGA Tour, competed on the Players West Tour, the Futures Tour, Central Florida Challenge and the Asian Tour, where she won 10 tournaments, including the Republic of China Open.

Amateur

Weiss captured four Minnesota State Amateur titles (three as an individual and one team event) from 1988-90. While competing for the University of Minnesota golf team, she was named to the Big Ten All-Conference Team and was selected as the University of Minnesota golf team's MVP in 1989.
