Professional

Career

- In 2007, recorded a career-best tie for third at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger, where she carded a season-low 68 in the opening round.
- In 2006, best finish was a tie for 16th at the Franklin American Mortgage Championship benefiting the Monroe Carell Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt; carded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the John Q. Hammons Hotel Classic presented by SemGroup; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament where she tied for seventh to earn exempt status for the 2007 LPGA season.
- In 2005, best finish of the season was at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger, where she tied for 12th and also notched her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the third round; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 39th to retain non-exempt status for the 2006 LPGA season.
- In 2004, posted a season-best finish at the LPGA Corning Classic, where she tied for 14th; returned to the LPGA Final

Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 52nd to retain non-exempt status for the 2005 LPGA season.

- In 2003, best finish was a tie for 20th at the Jamie Farr Kroger Classic Presented by ALLTEL, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 60th to earn non-exempt status for the 2004 LPGA season.
- In 2002, fired a career-low 66 during the first round of the Kellogg-Keebler Classic; best finish was a tie for 20th at the First Union Betsy King Classic.
- In 2001, best finish was a tie for 18th at the Sybase Big Apple Classic Presented by GOLF MAGAZINE.
- In 2000, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 20th to retain non-exempt status for the 2001 LPGA season.
- In 1999, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 27th to retain non-exempt status for the 2000 LPGA season.
- In 1998, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 52nd to retain non-exempt status for the 1999 LPGA season.
- In 1997, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament and gained non-exempt status for the 1998 LPGA season after finishing tied for 56th.
- From 1995-97, competed on the Futures Tour, and in 1995, competed on the Asian Tour.
- In 1993, turned professional in August, and originally qualified for the Tour by tying for 43rd at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament.

Amateur

Wood enjoyed a very successful amateur career. She was the 1988-89 Massachusetts State High School champion. She was the 1989 Massachusetts Amateur champion and runner-up at the 1991 U.S. Women's Amateur Public Links Championship. While a member of the Mississippi State University golf team, she captured four tournament titles and was a three-time All-American, three-time Southeastern Conference (SEC) Team member and the 1992 SEC individual champion.
