- Recorded her third LPGA Tour career hole-in-one during the second round of the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger, where she finished tied for 54th.

Career

- In 2008, carded a season-low 69 in the first round of both the Michelob ULTRA Open at Kingsmill and the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 13th at the LPGA State Farm Classic.
- In 2006, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the Florida's Natural Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez, where she tied her career-low 64 during the second round.
- In 2005, recorded a season-best finish at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger, where she tied for third; carded a career-low 64 in the first round of the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi; notched her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the third round of the Corona Morelia Championship and her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 2004, played on the Futures Tour, where she recorded eight top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for second at the Michelob ULTRA Futures Charity Golf Classic; recorded two top-five finishes on the Korea LPGA (KLPGA) Tour; tied for 10th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn exempt status for the 2005 LPGA Tour season.
- In 2003, competed on the KLPGA Tour, where her best finish was fourth place at the MBC X Canvas Women's Open Championship.
- In 2002, turned professional in November.

Amateur

Yim had a successful amateur career, as she won the 2001 Tiger Pools ToTo Women's Open Championship and the 2001 Korea Women's Amateur Championship. She also placed third at the 2001 Orange Bowl International Junior Golf Tournament. Yim was a member of the 2002 Korean National Team that won the gold medal at the 2002 Asian Games.
