## Professional

### Career

- In 2008, announced it would be her last official season on the LPGA Tour.
- In 2006, tied for 24th at the Fields Open in Hawaii for her best finish of the season.
- In 2005, recorded her best finish at the Longs Drugs Challenge, where she tied for 17th; representing Canada with Lorie Kane, tied for sixth at the inaugural Women's World Cup of Golf, an unofficial LPGA event.
- In 2004, recorded her best finish at the BMO Financial Group Canadian Women's Open, where she tied for fifth; crossed the \$3 million mark in career earnings at the Michelob ULTRA Open at Kingsmill.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for 14th at the Wachovia LPGA Classic hosted by Betsy King.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for 10th at the Asahi Ryokuken International Championship at Mount Vintage.
- In 2001, tied for sixth at the season-opening YourLife Vitamins LPGA Classic.
- In 2000, best finish was a tie for sixth at the Philips Invitational Honoring Harvey Penick, where she recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round.
- In 1999, best finish was fourth place at the du Maurier Classic.
- In 1998, recorded best finish at the du Maurier Classic with a tie for fourth; posted a career-low 63 during the final round of the SAFECO Classic.
- In 1997, best finish was a tie for fifth at the Safeway LPGA Golf Championship; crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings at the McDonald's LPGA Championship.
- In 1996, best finish was a tie for third at the CoreStates Betsy King Classic.
- In 1995, captured her third LPGA title at the Chrysler-Plymouth Tournament of Champions; competed in just 16 events due to the birth of her son James Richard.
- In 1994, captured her second LPGA title at the HEALTHSOUTH Palm Beach Classic; finished second at the Rochester International; recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the du Maurier Ltd. Classic.
- In 1993, tied for second at the Standard Register PING and placed third at the du Maurier Ltd. Classic; recorded her second career double-eagle during the first round of the Sara Lee Classic; is one of only two LPGA players with two career double-eagles (with Sherri Turner).
- In 1992, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the Women's Kemper Open; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings with a fifth-place finish at the U.S. Women's Open; narrowly missed out on her second victory of the season at the Oldsmobile Classic, losing in a sudden-death playoff to Colleen Walker; carded her first career double-eagle during the first round of the du Maurier Classic.
- In 1991, best finish was a third place at the Women's Kemper Open.
- In 1990, recorded seven top-10 finishes, including a tie for second at the Sara Lee Classic.● In 1989, top finish was a tie for second at the Cellular One-PING LPGA Golf Championship.
- In 1988, season-best finish was a tie for seventh at the Nabisco Dinah Shore.
- In 1987, tied for third at the MasterCard International.
- In 1986, tied for fourth at the Chrysler-Plymouth Classic.
- In 1985, posted her season-best finish at the Sarasota Classic, where she finished ninth.
- In 1984, best finish of her rookie season was a tie for 12th at the MasterCard International Pro-Am.
- In 1983, originally qualified for the LPGA Tour at the October LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she finished fifth.

## Amateur

Coe-Jones was the 1978-79 British Columbia Junior champion. She was the British Columbia Amateur champion from 1982-83, as well as the 1983 Canadian Amateur champion. While at Lamar University, she won the 1982 Dick McGuire Invitational and Husky Invitational and was a 1983 First-Team All-American.
