Career

- In 2009, best finish was a tie for 14th at the Corona Championship; recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the CN Canadian Women's Open.
- In 2008, carded a career-best tie for fifth at the MasterCard Classic Honoring Alejo Peralta Presented by Nextel; tied her career-low 66 in the first round of the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger.
- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 11th at the Navistar LPGA Classic, where she tied her career-low 66 in the third round.
- In 2006, recorded her season-best finish at the ShopRite LPGA Classic, where she tied for 19th.
- In 2005, best finish was a tie for 23rd at the Office Depot Championship at Trump National Golf Club Los Angeles.
- In 2004, best finish was a tie for 12th at the Welch's/Fry's Championship, where she tied her career-low 66 during the first and final rounds; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for seventh to earn exempt status for the 2005 LPGA season.
