Professional

Career

- In 2009, best finish was a tie for second at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 2008, recorded a season-best tie for 12th at the Wegmans LPGA, where she carded a season-low 68 in the first round, also recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round.
- In 2007, recorded a season-best tie for 22nd at the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi.
- In 2006, recorded a season-best tie for ninth at The Mitchell Company LPGA Tournament of Champions presented by Kathy Ireland Worldwide.
- In 2005, became one of 10 Rolex First-Time Winners at the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi, where she tied her career-low 64 during the opening round; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings with the victory.
- In 2004, best of three top-10 finishes was a tie for eighth at the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by Coca-Cola.
- In 2003, had a breakout year with six top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for second at the LPGA Takefujii Classic; posted a career-low 64 during the second round of the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 2002, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for seventh to earn exempt status for the 2003 LPGA season.
- In 2000, competed on the Korea LPGA (KLPGA) Tour, where she won the Korea Women's Open, the Hite Ladies Open and captured the Asian Open title for the third time; qualified for the LPGA Tour by tying for 49th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2001 LPGA season.

- From 1999-2000, competed on the Futures Tour, where she recorded four top-10 finishes.
- In 1997, turned professional.

Kang's amateur career culminated with wins at the 1996 Rose Ladies Open in Korea and the World Amateur Championship.
