Professional

Career

- In 2009, best finish was a tie for 20th at the Michelob ULTRA Open at Kingsmill and the Safeway Classic Presented by Coca-Cola.
- In 2008, best finish was a tie for third at the Stanford International Pro-Am, where she crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings; also recorded a fifth-place finish at the Grand China Air LPGA and tie for seventh at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger.
- In 2007, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the LPGA Corning Classic, where she carded four consecutive rounds in the 60s.
- In 2006, recorded five top-10 finishes, including a tie for eighth at both the Franklin American Mortgage Championship benefiting the Monroe Carell, Jr. Children's Hospital at Vanderbilt; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings with a tie for 24th at the LPGA Takefuji Classic.
- In 2005, recorded six top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for third at the Weetabix Women's British Open and the Mizuno Classic, where she tied her career-low 63 in the final round.
- In 2004, recorded three top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for fifth at the Sybase Classic Presented by Lincoln Mercury; ended the season with back-to-back ties for seventh at the CJ Nine Bridges Classic Presented by Sports Today and the Mizuno Classic.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for sixth at the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by AIG; carded a career-low 63 in the first round of the Welch's/Fry's Championship, which included a 28 (-7) on the back nine and her first LPGA career hole-in-one.
- In 2002, tied for fourth at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn exempt status for the 2003 LPGA season.

- In 2001, won the Barona Creek Women's Golf Classic on the Futures Tour.
- From 1998-2001, played on the Korea LPGA (KLPGA) Tour, where she was a two-time tournament champion.
- In March 1998, turned professional.

Kim is a four-time winner of the Korea Golf Association Junior Championship and in 1997, won the Japan Golf Association Junior Championship.
