Professional

2008

- Best finish was a tie for sixth at the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by Coca-Cola.
- Carded a season-low 66 in the final round of the SBS Open at Turtle Bay, where she finished tied for 12th.

Career

- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 24th at the MasterCard Classic Honoring Alejo Peralta Presented by Televisa Deportes;

returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she finished fourth to earn exempt status for the 2008 LPGA season.

- In 2006, best finish was a tie for fifth at the Corona Morelia Championship; crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger.
- In 2005, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 39th to earn non-exempt status for the 2006 LPGA season.
- In 2004, best finish was fourth place at the Sybase Classic Presented by Lincoln Mercury; tied for sixth at the John Q. Hammons Hotel Classic presented by Ford; during the second round of the LPGA Corning Classic, where she eventually tied for eighth, became the seventh player in LPGA history to record back-to-back eagles.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for ninth at the Wegmans Rochester LPGA; was a captain's pick for the U.S. Solheim Cup Team and posted a 2-2-0 record.
- In 2002, recorded six top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for fourth at The Office Depot Championship Hosted by Amy Alcott; one of five "rookies" on the victorious U.S. Solheim Cup Team.
- In 2001, recorded a total of five top-10 finishes, including a season-best tie for fifth at the Wegmans Rochester International; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings at the AFLAC Champions Presented by Southern Living.
- In 2000, came close to successfully defending her title at the LPGA Corning Classic, eventually losing in a three-way, sudden-death playoff to Betsy King; the tie for second was her best finish of the season; recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round of the Arch Wireless Championship.
- In 1999, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the LPGA Corning Classic; tied for second at the Jamie Farr Kroger Classic, where she lost in a six-way, sudden-death playoff to Se Ri Pak; fired a career-low 64 during the first round of the U.S. Women's Open, where she placed third.
- In 1998, best finish came at the First Union Betsy King Classic, where she tied for 20th.
- In 1997, qualified for the Tour by tying for fifth at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn exempt status for the 1998 LPGA season.
- In 1996, turned professional.

Amateur

Kuehne owns an impressive amateur resume. She is the winner of three USGA titles: 1994 U.S. Girls' Junior Amateur Championship; 1995 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship; and 1996 U.S. Women's Amateur Championship. Also in 1996, Kuehne won the Women's British Amateur Championship, was a member of the 1996 U.S. Curtis Cup and World Cup Amateur Teams and earned First-Team All-American honors at the University of Texas. Kuehne was recognized for her amateur accomplishments with induction into the Texas Sports Hall of Fame.
