- Finished tied for 12th at the Safeway Classic Presented by Coca-Cola; tied for 31st at the RICOH Women's British Open; tied for 32nd at the P&G NW Arkansas Championship Presented by Walmart; tied for 39th at the Tres Marias Championship; tied for 45th at the CN Canadian Women's Open and tied for 53rd at the Evian Masters Presented by Société Générale and the CVS/pharmacy LPGA Challenge.

Career

- In 2009, recorded her second LPGA Tour victory at the Sybase Classic Presented by ShopRite, where she crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings and recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round; carded her career-low 65 in the third round of the Navistar LPGA Classic Presented by Monaco RV, where she finished tied for eighth; also tied for sixth at the MasterCard Classic Honoring Alejo Peralta.
- In 2008, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the LPGA State Farm Classic, where she carded back-to-back season-low 66s in the first two rounds and all rounds in the 60s; defeated Yani Tseng in a one-hole, sudden-death playoff; recorded three additional top-10 finishes including a tie for eighth at the MasterCard Classic Honoring Alejo Peralta Presented by Nextel; a tie for ninth at the Grand China Air LPGA; and a tie for 10th at the Jamie Farr Owens Corning Classic Presented by Kroger.
- In 2007, best finish was sixth at the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi, where she carded a season-low 66 in the opening round.
- In 2006, competed as an amateur at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament and tied for ninth to earn exempt status for the 2007 LPGA season; turned professional immediately following the final round.
