Professional

2010

- Finished tied for 16th at the Bell Micro LPGA Classic; tied for 22nd at the ShopRite LPGA Classic; tied for 34th at the LPGA Championship Presented by Wegmans; tied for 41st at the U.S. Women's Open; tied for 45th at the Safeway Classic Presented by Coca-Cola and the CN Canadian Women's Open; tied for 46th at the CVS/pharmacy LPGA Challenge and finished 75th at the RICOH Women's British Open.

Career

- In 2009, best finish was a tie for 17th at the Safeway Classic Presented by Coca-Cola.
- In 2008, best finish was a tie for 12th at the CN Canadian Women's Open; teamed up for the Philippines with Dorothy Delasin to win the Women's World Cup of Golf, an unofficial LPGA event.

- In 2006, best finish was a tie for 29th at the Kraft Nabisco Championship.
- In 2005, won her second career title at the SBS Open at TurtleBay; posted seven additional top-20 finishes; crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings at the CJ Nine Bridges Classic Presented by Sports Today; partnered with Dorothy Delasin to represent the Philippines and tied for second at the Women's World Cup of Golf, an unofficial LPGA event.
- In 2004, became a Rolex First-Time Winner and the first player from the Philippines to win on the LPGA Tour at the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez, where she posted a season-low 65 in the final round and crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings; recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round of the State Farm Classic.
- In 2003, tied for second at the Giant Eagle LPGA Classic, where she lost in a four-way, three-hole sudden-death playoff to Rachel (Hetherington) Teske; carded a career-low 64 during the second round.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for fourth at the Weetabix Women's British Open.
- In 2001, tied for third at The Office Depot for her best finish of the season.
- In 2000, best finish came at the U.S. Women's Open, where she tied for 12th.
- In 1999, tied for seventh at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to gain exempt status for the 2000 LPGA season.

Amateur

Rosales was a five-time champion of the Philippine Ladies Amateur Open (1994-98). In 1998, as a competitor on the USC women's golf team, she won the NCAA individual championship as a freshman and won the *Golf World* Invitational.
