Professional

2008

- Recorded a season-best tie for 11th at the Navistar LPGA Classic Presented by MaxxForce.
- Partnered with Cindy Figg-Currier to win the BJ's Charity Championship on The Legends Tour – the Official Legends Tour of the LPGA.
- Carded back-to-back season-low 66s during the first and second rounds of the LPGA State Farm Classic, where she tied for 25th.

Career

- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 12th at the Safeway Classic Presented by Pepsi; recorded her sixth LPGA career hole-in-one during the final round of the Michelob ULTRA Open at Kingsmill.
- In 2006, best finish was a tie for eighth at the Florida's Natural Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez, where she tied her career-low 63 during the third round.
- In 2005, recorded a season-best tie for 12th at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 2004, played in eight events before undergoing right shoulder surgery and was forced to miss the remainder of the season.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for 29th at the Safeway PING Presented by Yoplait; was hampered by tendonitis in her right wrist throughout the season.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for 16th at the Aerus Electrolux USA Championship Hosted by Vince Gill and Amy Grant.
- In 2001, best finish was a tie for fourth at the U.S. Women's Open, where she crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings.
- In 2000, best finish was a tie for fifth at the LPGA Takefuji Classic; carded her fifth LPGA career hole-in-one during the third round of the Los Angeles Women's Championship.
- In 1999, best finish was second place at the U.S. Women's Open; recorded her fourth LPGA career hole-in-one during the final round of the du Maurier Classic.
- In 1998, best finish was a tie for 10th at the Safeway LPGA Golf Championship; carded her second career double-eagle during the first round of the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship, joining Dawn Coe-Jones as the only LPGA players with two double-eagles.
- In 1997, best finish was a tie for 15th at the Alpine Australian Ladies Open; named William and Mousie Powell Award winner.
- In 1996, best finish was a tie for eighth at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 1995, best finish was a tie for third at the NabiscoDinahShore; tied her career-low 63 during the final round of the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship, where she tied for fourth.
- In 1994, best of six top-20 finishes was a tie for fourth at the GHP Heartland Classic.
- In 1993, best finish was seventh at the Atlanta Women's Championship, where she recorded a double-eagle during the second round.
- In 1992, best finish was a tie for 15th at the Rochester International; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings with a tie for 18th at the Oldsmobile Classic.
- In 1991, top finish was a tie for eighth at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 1990, season-best finish was a tie for fourth at both the Orix Hawaiian Ladies Open and PING-Cellular One Golf Championship; recorded her second and third LPGA career holes-in-one just six days apart, during the first round of the Rail Charity Golf Classic and the first round of the PING-Cellular One Golf Championship.
- In 1989, collected her third career victory at the Orix Hawaiian Ladies Open.
- In 1988, won back-to-back tournaments, her first career victory at the Mazda LPGA Championship followed by the LPGA Corning Classic, where she posted her career-best score of 63 during the second round; tied for second at the Sara Lee

Classic after a four-way, sudden-death playoff against eventual winner Patti Rizzo (Turner made her first LPGA career hole-in-one on the 71st hole to earn a spot in the playoff); finished second at the Lady Keystone Open after a sudden-death playoff with Shirley Furlong.

- In 1987, top finish was third place at the Atlantic City LPGA Classic.
- In 1986, best finish was a tie for fourth at the Lady Keystone Open.
- In 1985, season-best finish was a tie for fifth at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 1984, best of four top-10 finishes was second place at the Elizabeth Arden Classic, her first event as an LPGA professional.
- In 1983, qualified for the Tour by finishing 11th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn exempt status for the 1984 LPGA season.
- In 1979, turned professional and played on the WSGT Mini-Tour from 1979-84.

Amateur

A golfer by the age of 5, Turner was the 1974-75 Carolinas Junior champion. While playing for Furman University, she was a medalist at three tournaments, including the Women's Southern Intercollegiate. She was selected to the All-American Team in 1979.
