## Professional

### Career

- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 22nd at the Corona Championship.
- In 2006, best finish was a tie for 19th at the Sybase Classic Presented by Lincoln Mercury; recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the Weetabix Women's British Open.
- In 2005, equaled her career-best finish at the Wegmans Rochester LPGA, where she tied for 18th; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for second to earn exempt status for 2006.
- In 2004, posted her career-low 66 on two occasions: second round of the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez and the first round of the LPGA Corning Classic; recorded her career-best finish at the Gian Eagle LPGA Classic, where she tied for 18th and recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tie for second to earn exempt status for 2005.
- In 2003, competed in 10 events on the Futures Tour, posted three top-10 finishes, including a win at the Florida Hospital Futures Golf Classic; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tie for 22nd and earned exempt status for the 2004 LPGA season in an eight-way, three-hole playoff.
- In 2002, competed on the Futures Tour, where she posted one top-10 finish; returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 51st to earn non-exempt status for the 2003 LPGA season.
- In 2000, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 49th to earn non-exempt status for the 2001 season.
- In 1999, tied for 46th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to gain non-exempt status for the 2000 LPGA season.
- In 1995, turned professional and began competing on the Futures Tour, where she posted 13 top-10 finishes.

## Amateur

Walker-Cooper was the 1993 North Carolina Amateur champion and co-champion in 1994.
