Career

- In 2007, best finish was a tie for 24th at the MasterCard Classic Honoring Alejo Peralta Presented by Televisa Deportes.
- In 2006, best finish was a tie for 17th at the John Q. Hammons Hotel Classic presented by SemGroup.
- In 2005, notched her third LPGA career hole-in-one during the first round of the BMO Financial Group Canadian Women's Open.
- In 2004, best finish was a tie for 16th at the Asahi Ryokuken International Championship at MountVintage.
- In 2003, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for fifth to earn exempt status for the 2004 LPGA season.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for 18th at the Safeway Classic.
- In 2001, best finish was a tie for 10th at the McDonald's LPGA Championship Presented by AIG; recorded her second LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the Cup Noodles Hawaiian Ladies Open.
- In 2000, recorded two top-10 finishes: a tie for seventh at the Safeway LPGA Golf Championship, where she crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings, and a tie for 10th at the Weetabix Women's British Open.
- In 1999, best finish was a tie for sixth at the du Maurier Classic, her best finish in a major.
- In 1998, limited to 13 events due to shoulder surgery in September; best finish was a tie for 13th at The Office Depot.
- In 1997, top finish was sixth at the Susan G. Komen International.
- In 1996, best finish was a tie for second at the Star Bank LPGA Classic; recorded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the final round of the Chrysler-Plymouth Tournament of Champions.
- In 1995, best finish was sixth place at the PING Welch's Championship in Boston.
- In 1994, won her third career title at the Children's Medical Center LPGA Classic by defeating Jill Briles-Hinton and Alicia Dibos on the second hole of a sudden-death playoff.
- In 1993, top finish was a tie for 12th at the Jamie Farr Toledo Classic, where she fired a career-low 65 during the third round.
- In 1992, won the Sara Lee Classic by defeating Amy Benz and Brandie Burton on the first hole of a sudden-death playoff.
- In 1991, top finish was a tie for sixth at the Phar-Mor at Inverrary.
- In 1990, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the Desert Inn LPGA International.
- In 1989, her rookie season, best finish was a tie for third at the Mitsubishi Motors Ocean State Open.
- In 1988, qualified for the Tour by tying for 20th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1989 LPGA season.
- Prior to joining the LPGA Tour, competed on the Futures Tour.

Amateur

Will was runner-up at the 1980 Carolinas PGA Junior Championship and captured the title from 1981-82. She added a runner-up finish in 1982 at the PING Junior Classic. In 1985, Will participated in the Henredon Classic as an amateur and finished fifth at the North Carolina Women's Amateur. The following season, she won the North Carolina Women's Amateur. At FurmanUniversity, she was a member of the 1987 runner-up NCAA Championship team.
