### **Sink 'em!**

To keep a putt on line to the hole, you must keep the center of the putter face on line as well. For a straight/flat putt, aim the center of the putter face to the center of the hole, and keep it on that line in your follow through. When the putter finishes its stroke, the center of the clubface should still be pointing at the hole. For breaking putts, use the same method, but aim the center of the putter face on the line that you wish the ball to START rolling on, and keep it on that line until the finish of the stroke. When your putter face stays straight on the intended target line, your chance of making the putt greatly increases.

To make more putts, use this simple alignment idea and watch 'em fall!
