Distance putting

When having trouble gauging the distance of a putt, try visualizing the ball rolling on the proper path to the hole and then returning on the same path back to the putter. This "yo-yo" visual could give you a better feel for the exact end of the putt. You can even go so far as to feel the ball come back and hit the putter with the impact you think would be appropriate for that length of putt. The back-and-forth roll seen several times before you putt is a way of creating an indelible image and keying you into sensing how hard to hit the ball.
