WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Skies have cleared nicely this afternoon as drier air from the north has pushed into the area helping to shove all the clouds to our south. This will set us up for a very nice, but chilly overnight, as mostly clear skies are expected with lows falling back to near the 50 degree mark. So for Sunday will go with mostly sunny skies, temperatures in the lower to middle 70s, low humidity, and winds continuing out of the northwest, about 10 to 15. Another chilly one expected for Sunday night-early Monday morning as lows once again fall back, but this time into the upper 40s.
