### WEATHER SYNOPSIS

High pressure still remains over the area today, which will result in similar weather conditions as yesterday. Starting off this morning with generally clear skies and temperatures in the upper 50s. This is about a couple of degrees warmer than yesterday morning and this will generally be the rule for today compared to yesterday as highs will reach about 2 to 3 degrees warmer than yesterday. There are some areas of high thin cirrus around the region this morning, however this wont really make a big dent in sky conditions today, so will go with mainly sunny skies this morning with a few typical afternoon clouds developing after lunch today. Tonight expecting a clear sky early and then partly cloudy skies later as some high clouds begin to move in from the west. Lows expected to fall back to around the 60-degree mark by early tomorrow morning. The high begins to break down tomorrow, however still expecting another dry day in our forecast. Partly cloudy skies with highs warming into the upper 80s as upper flow becomes more southerly.
