### WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Updating forecast this morning for wind speed. Winds are blowing a little stronger this morning than anticipated earlier. So will increase winds today, 10 to 20 with some higher gusts. Winds could still calm down a bit this afternoon, but for now will use a watch and wait attitude.

Previous Synopsis: Expecting a very nice end to our week today with generally sunny skies, although a few high thin clouds could slide into the area this afternoon. Starting off this morning with plenty of sunshine but with temperatures a bit on the cool side. But strong June sun will quickly begin to work on that as we warm into the lower 70s by late this afternoon. There is a stationary front sitting across central Virginia and northern North Carolina this morning and a wave of energy is expected to move from the northwest to southeast along that front today. Not expecting that to bring us any rain, however could see some high level cloudiness move in from the west. So skies could become a little more partly cloudy later this afternoon. Winds today not as near as strong as yesterday, generally 10 to 15 out of the northwest to west.
