

Hole 10 (Par 4, 453 yards)

A downhill slope influenced by a right-to-left wind. The green favors a right-to-left approach and the contoured green is uphill.



Hole 11 (Par 5, 533 yards)

A slight double dog-leg right for those who do not reach the green in two. A long drive helped by the wind, will hit off the right mounds and catch some roll. From there, avoid the deep bunker front right, Don't over hit the green, as the back bunker presents a very difficult up-and-down.

Hole 12 (Par 4, 395 yards)

Another slight double dog-leg right-to-left. The tee shot should be right with a draw left. The green slopes to the left.
