



Hole 7 (Par 4, 441 yards)

The drive is downhill and sets up a second shot into the wind. If your approach lands in the deep bunker, front left, watch out as the green slopes severely to the back.



Hole 8 (Par 4, 438 yards)

Hit the tee shot down the left side with a left-to-right fade. Watch out for the wind on the second shot – the lake may come into play.



Hole 9 (Par 5, 525 yards)

Rolling dog-leg left. Try to hit the tee shot right-to-left to catch the fairway on the left side. The risk taken will allow the right-to-left approach. If you lay up, check the pin placement for the best landing area.
