WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Partly sunny skies over the region as strong northeast winds continue. High pressure centered to the north and low pressure strengthening out in the western Atlantic are teaming up to create a strong pressure gradient, thus the strong gusty winds. Expect this to continue through Sunday, as the low doesn't really want to move off to the east very quickly. Actually it may even move slightly back to the northwest. Skies will clear a little tonight towards sunset with skies becoming mostly clear. But high clouds moving in from the west will bring us a more partly cloudy sky. Overnight lows expected to cool back to around the 60-degree mark. Partly cloudy skies expected tomorrow with an approaching system from the west. Mid and high level clouds will continue to increase out ahead of the system, but no rain is expected from this. Highs tomorrow, slightly cooler in the low 80s, mainly due to the extra cloud cover.
