**WEATHER SYNOPSIS**

Pretty simple forecast here as high pressure both here at the surface and aloft will provide us a very warm, actually hot, and humid day in our forecast. Starting off with sunny skies with temperatures in the lower 70s and expecting those temperatures to reach into the middle 90s by late this afternoon. Combine the humidity, heat indices will reach near the 100 degree mark. Practically no clouds expected today, except some high level cirrus from convection to our west, as warm air aloft will create a very strong cap on the atmosphere, which doesn't allow for any vertical movement of air, which leads to cloud development. More of the same expected tomorrow, although slightly warmer as highs reach into the upper 90s and heat indices go above 100.
