WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Starting off this early morning with the end of a passing isolated shower, and I do mean isolated, as it was the only one around the entire region. Starting off the day with generally cloudy skies, however a few breaks of sun will be seen today, so will just go with a mostly cloudy start. Weather story for today will be the approach of a frontal boundary and its associated rain chances. This front is helping to draw more moisture into the area from the south. Models aren't all that impressive with the precip chances here, however they do indicate a decent shot of scattered shower and thunderstorms considering when we add daytime heating to the mix. Best rain chances however still look to be confined to later tonight and into the morning hours tomorrow when that front is expected to be moving through our area, but don't rule out an isolated shower/storm this morning (i.e. shower earlier this morning). Otherwise highs today will reach into the middle 80s, upper 80s if we get some significant breaks of sun. Winds today generally out of the south around 10, but some higher winds will be likely prior to any showers/storms moving into the area.

TOMORROW	Mostly cloudy with scattered showers and thunderstorms, especially early.	85°	54%	SW to NW 10
