WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Starting off this morning with partly sunny skies and temperatures in the upper 50s. A few showers around the area as well, but they have pretty much moved on to the north and east of the area. So for the remainder of the morning, expecting mainly a mix of sun and clouds (partly sunny) with a slight chance of a shower or two. We also wont rule out the possibility of a thunderstorm as well. But as we go into the afternoon and evening hours, instability will build and showers and thunderstorms will become more likely. Highs today expected to reach just above the 70-degree mark by late this afternoon.

TONIGHT	Showers and thunderstorms likely in the evening, then a few showers lingering through the overnight hours.	55°	89%	SE 10-15
TOMORROW	Partly sunny am, then more clouds in the afternoon with a few scattered showers and thunderstorms.	69°	52%	S 10-15
