WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Scattered t-storms have developed along a warm front in Southwestern Ohio this afternoon. A few of those storms will move into the area mainly after 6 pm. Meanwhile a complex of t-storms is expected to develop in Southern Indiana and Western Kentucky late this afternoon/early evening. Those t-storms will move into the Dublin area late tonight (after 9 pm) and will continue into the early morning hours on Sunday. A break in the precipitation is expected in the morning hours before a cold front drops southeastward into Ohio. This will be the focus for redevelopment of t-storms late in the morning into the early afternoon. Some of these t-storms will produce heavy downpours and gusty winds. At this time, it appears that the cold front will move south of the area allowing for another break in the precipitation late in the afternoon/early evening.
