**WEATHER SYNOPSIS**

All the mid and high-level cloudiness from yesterday cleared out of the region during the overnight and this has left us a generally sunny start to our day. However, although the absence of clouds this morning makes for pleasant conditions, this absence could also lead to shower and thunderstorm development this afternoon. Upper level low pressure forecasted to move through the region later this afternoon. And with more sunshine expected today, this allows for good daytime heating to induce shower/storm development. But a few obstacles would have to be cleared before that can happen. Limited moisture in place for showers and storms to develop would be the first hurdle to cross. And stable air in the middle levels of the atmosphere being the second. So, in all, any showers and storms that would want to develop, will have a tough hill to climb first. So, will go with sunny skies in the morning, then partly cloudy by the afternoon with small chances of showers/storms in the afternoon and evening hours. Tomorrow appears to have a better shot of seeing showers and storms, although scattered and mainly afternoon and evening.
