WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Well finally a dry forecast for a change, for the most part, as all the precip from yesterday's system is now a fading memory. Starting off this morning on the cool side, well at least cool compared to the past few mornings. Still a little in the way of cloud cover this morning but skies will become partly cloudy by late morning. A little weather 101 for you here. Surface low pressure and associated cold fronts always (in most cases) have upper level low pressure support centered back behind, or to the west of the surface lows. Usually the upper low follows the surface low and so when the surface low leaves the area, the upper low usually follows on its heels and departs behind it. Again, usually. In our case, the upper low associated with yesterday's surface low lagged behind too long and now has become cut off from the main flow of the jet, therefore having no place to go now. So with that said, with this upper now low stuck sitting out across western PA this morning, the strong June sun will be able to interact with the lows cold air aloft and produce some showers and storms well out to our west today. As this stuff moves east, some of it could hold together long enough to warrant a slight chance of a shower later this evening. But the low should drift closer to the area beginning tonight and into the day tomorrow to bring better chances of a few showers and even a couple thunderstorms to the area for tonight and into the day on Monday.
