### WEATHER SYNOPSIS

Starting off this morning with very chilly temperature readings around the 40-degree mark. Cold front that moved through yesterday morning has now pushed well onto the east and drier and cooler high pressure has begun to build in from the northwest. Still have some high thin clouds streaming across the region to our south, so will go with a mostly sunny forecast today to account for that cloud cover. Highs today will remain below the seasonable norm for this time of year, reaching into the middle 60s by late this afternoon. Another chilly one expected again as lows fall back once again to near the 40-degree mark under clear skies. And mainly sunny skies back in the forecast for tomorrow with temperatures slightly warmer to around the 70-degree mark.
