

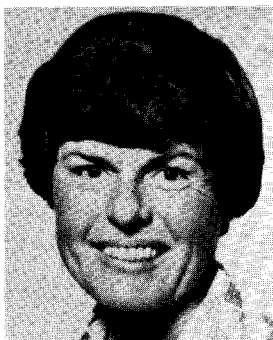

CAREER

Amateur: Kathy won the Southern Amateur championship in 1952 and was medalist in the Florida Intercollegiate in 1953. She was also runner-up in that event in both 1951 and 1953.

Professional: Although Kathy turned pro in 1953 just after her marriage, she did not join the Tour until three years later. She won two events in her first full year, 1956, including the U.S. Open, and has added five more titles since. Her best season was 1973 as she won more than \$40,000 and finished eighth on the final money list. She won over \$14,000 in 1980, her best since 1977, with her best finish a share of eighth in the first event of the year, the Whirlpool Championship of Deer Creek.

5'6", 124 lbs., brown hair, brown eyes . . . Married in July of 1953 to golf pro Bill Cornelius . . . Attended Florida Southern where she majored in journalism and played on the men's golf team . . .
