### Career Highlights

- Currently head coach for the Macalester (Minn.) College men's golf team.
- In 1999, best finish was a tie for 15<sup>th</sup> at the Michelob Light Classic.
- In 1998, best finish was a tie for 18<sup>th</sup> at the State Farm Rail Classic.
- In 1996, tied for second after losing to Karrie Webb on the fourth hole of a sudden-death playoff at the HEALTHSOUTH Inaugural.
- In 1995, best finish was a tie for 15<sup>th</sup> at the Chrysler-Plymouth Tournament of Champions.
- In 1994, captured her third career victory at the du Maurier Ltd. Classic, one of the LPGA Tour's four major championships, where she tied her career-low score of 65 during the first round; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings.
- In 1993, spent much of the season rehabilitating from Ramsay Hunt Syndrome that caused nerve damage in her ear; best finish was a tie for 16<sup>th</sup> at the Sara Lee Classic.
- In 1992, played in only 19 events due to the diagnosis of Ramsay Hunt Syndrome in mid-July; best finish was a tie for sixth at the Standard Register PING.
- In 1991, won the LPGA Chicago *Sun-Times* Shoot-Out by a stroke after holing her approach shot at the final hole for an eagle-three; her final-round score of 65 tied a career-best.
- In 1990, posted seven top-20 finishes, including a season-best tie for 11<sup>th</sup> at the Standard Register Turquoise Classic.
- In 1989, best finish was second place at the Red Robin Kyocera Inamori Classic.
- In 1988, captured her first career win at the Planters Pat Bradley International; posted a career-low round of 65 during the final round of the Ai Star/Centinel Hospital Classic.
- In 1987, best finish was third place at the Lady Keystone Open.
- In 1986, best finish was seventh place at the Rail Charity Classic.
- In 1985, top finish was a tie for fifth at the Rail Charity Classic; she was out of competition for nine weeks due to impingement syndrome and acromioplasty surgery to her left shoulder.
- In 1984, best finish was a tie for second at the Lady Keystone Open.
- In 1983, season-best performance was sixth place at the Chrysler-Plymouth Charity Classic.
- In 1982, top finish was second place at the WUI Classic.
