Meet Your Speakers

Kelly Rothberg – LPGA Class A member and Head Women’s Golf Coach, University of Louisville in Louisville, Kentucky since 2000. In her first season at the University of Louisville, Rothberg was voted the 2000 Conference USA Coach of the Year. Rothberg earned the honor after guiding her squad to a second place finish in the Conference USA Championships. While at Louisville, Rothberg has coached six players that went on to earn All-Conference USA honors and six players that have earned All-BIG EAST honors. Six of her players have gone on to win Title honors at different tournaments.

Rothberg has over 26 years of amateur and professional experience. She spent four seasons as assistant coach with the University of Florida program. In the spring of 1998, she took over as interim head coach and led the Lady Gators to a second place finish in the NCAA championships. Prior to her stint at Florida, Rothberg served as the assistant golf pro at Tucson National Golf and Conference Resort. She also served as a golf instructor at Eastern Wyoming College from 1991-93 and as an amateur assistant at Meadowbrook Golf Course in Rapid City, S.D., in 1990. Rothberg set numerous records at the University of Wyoming where she earned her degree in business administration in 1990.

A native of South Dakota, Rothberg played in the Players West Mini Tour in California for three seasons (1992-94) and won the 1994 Rose Hogan Commemorative Award, posted several top finishes, including two top-10 mini-tour placings during the 1994 season. She also competed for 16 years as an amateur taking home various titles including the 1988 South Dakota Women’s Amateur Championship. She was a six-time qualifier for the National Publix Amateur and set a number of course records.

Rothberg has served on the NGCA Awards Committee and the NGCA Ethics Committee. She also served on the Regional Advisory Committee and has been a Class A member of the LPGA Teaching and Club Professional (T&CP) membership since 2001.

Dianne Dailey – LPGA Class A member; Women’s Golf Coach, Wake Forest University. Dailey has been the women’s golf coach at Wake Forest University (WFU) in Winston-Salem, N.C., since 1988 and associate athletic director since 1996.

Dailey’s awards include Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC) Coach of the Year, 1994 and 1995; National Golf Coaches Association (NGCA) District Coach of the Year, 1994, 1996 and 2000; Ladies Professional Golf Association (LPGA) Sectional Coach of the Year presented by Spalding (Southeast Section), 1994 and 1998; and the Gladys Palmer Service Award from the NGCA for her efforts as association president, 1995.

Dailey served 11 years as the senior women’s administrator at WFU, was chairman of the NCAA Golf Committee and is currently the associate director of the College Golf Foundation.

A native of Frankfort, Ky., Dailey graduated from Salem College (Winston-Salem, N.C.) and gained her master's degree from North Carolina State (Raleigh, N.C.). After working as assistant academic dean at Salem College (1976-79), she joined the LPGA Tour from 1979-88 and became a Class A member of the LPGA Teaching and Club Professional (T&CP) Membership in 1992.
