

Driving Directions Kiawah Island, South Carolina

From Charleston International Airport:

Take the airport terminal road to I-526, referred to as the Mark Clark Expressway. Turn right at the stop light towards Savannah. Travel to the end of the expressway and turn right onto Highway 17 South. Travel approximately 5 miles to the Intersection of Highway 17 and Main Road.

Turn left on to Main Road, see Burger King, and continue for 18 miles to the entrance of Kiawah Island.

Note: On this 18 mile road, you will come to one major intersection – travel straight through (McDonald's on your left) – at this intersection Main Road changes names to <u>Bohicket Road</u> right at the intersection of Main Road and Maybank Highway.

You will come to a roundabout – follow around to your left until you come to the last right (Kiawah Island Parkway). Follow the parkway to the Security gate, if needed stop to pick up your Island vehicle pass – it will be at the gate in your last name. You will be securing an "All Sites" pass which allows you to the entire Island.

From Downtown Charleston: Take Highway 17 South over the Ashley River Bridge (past the round Holiday Inn). After the bridge, bear to the left on Highway 171—toward Folly Beach. Pass over the Wappoo Cut Bridge onto James Island. Just over the bridge, turn right onto Highway 700 (also known as Maybank Highway) at the first intersection. Travel Maybank Highway past the Municipal Golf Course and across the Stono River Bridge.

Travel Maybank Highway, turning left onto Bohicket Road (McDonald's on the left). Approach roundabout and follow signs to Kiawah Island, the third exit.

Kiawah Island Club Facilities

Cassique

100 Old Cedar Lane

Travel through the roundabout, passing Freshfields Village on your right. In approximately a ½ mile there will be a lane to veer right. Take this right – see Kiawah Island Club sign - you are now on Old Cedar Lane. Continue straight to the guard house - gate code is #1233. The Cassique Clubhouse will be about 1 mile ahead. To access the Cassique Tent, use the main Clubhouse entrance and continue through the right side of the Clubhouse and down through the garden.

The Beach Club

225 Ocean Marsh Drive

Travel Kiawah Island Parkway through the second gate, Vanderhorst – turn right on Governor's Drive – travel for approximately 4.6 miles – you will pass a Fire House on left – travel a bit further and turn right onto Ocean Marsh Drive (Kiawah Island Club sign at Ocean Marsh Drive) – gate code #1233.

Cassique Cottages: Travel through the roundabout, passing Freshfields Village on your right. Approximately ½ mile there will be a lane to veer right. Take this right see Kiawah Island Club sign - you are now on Old Cedar Lane. Take this lane and continue to the guard house - gate code is #1233. After 10:00 pm the gate code is #5050. As you approach the *Cassique* Clubhouse take a right into the parking lot and continue through the parking lot and *Cassique* Cottages will be on your left.

There are two Cottages:

1) Links Cottage: 3 Dennison Lane, first on right – 843-768-6218

2) Watson Cottage: 1 Dennison Lane, second on right – 843-768-6198

Freshfields Village

From the Island: Pass through the Kiawah Island Main Gate and continue on the Kiawah Island Parkway for about 2 miles. You will approach the roundabout on your left and take the first entrance on your left into Freshfields Village.

Entering the Island: From Bohicket Road/Betsy Kerrison Parkway, enter the Island roundabout and take your second right into Freshfields Village.
