Career Highlights

- Pat is a five-time member of the U.S. Solheim Cup Team (1998, 2000, 2002, 2005, 2007) with a 10-7-3 overall record
- Enters 2013 ranked 20th on the LPGA Career Money List with nearly \$7 million in earnings
- Won her third-career title at the Electrolux USA Championship Hosted by Vince Gill and Amy Grant on May 14, 2000, her first Mother's Day
- Won her first and only major championship at the 1998 Nabisco Dinah Shore, now called the Kraft Nabisco Championship; she opted to dip a foot into the pond rather than the traditional champions' jump
- Named 1995 Louise Suggs Rolex Rookie of the Year
- Tied for 20th at the 1994 LPGA Final Qualifying
 Tournament to earn exempt status for the 1995 season
- Won the 1989 NCAA Championship individual title at San Jose State and also led her squad to the team title the same year
