- Crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings at the 2008 U.S. Women's Open
- In 2001, finished T31 at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 2002 LPGA season
- From 2000-02, competed on the Ladies European Tour (LET), where her career-best finish was a tie for third at the 2001 Ladies French Open
- In 2000, earned the Bill Johnson Rookie of the Year award as the leading rookie on the LET Order of Merit
- Sergas was the 1998 European Amateur champion
